PRESENTATION

Description

Courses are oriented towards the development of oral and written expression and comprehension skills. Achievement of autonomy in the use of French requires the acquisition of grammar, vocabulary and specific aspects of French culture. A variety of linguistic activities are offered to students and involve the use of specific methods, exercise books and real-life documents: press, adverts, cartoons, written texts, videos... The courses require students to participate on an active basis.

Public

This programme is aimed at all international students including adults, technicians and researchers... regardless of their level of French, who wish to:

- acquire and improve their skills in spoken and written French
- and/or prepare for <u>DELF</u> and <u>DALF</u>.

The ILCF teaches students in groups (of 18 to 24 students) according to their level: **A1** Breakthrough > **A2** Waystage > **B1** Threshold > **B2** Vantage

PROGRAMME DETAILS

Course length

60 hours | 20 hours per week

The intensive programme includes 20 hours of teaching each week : **Levels A1 to B2**: 60 hours of common curriculum

The courses are taught on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays in the mornings and/or afternoons.

Education certificate

The training is completed by a Certificate of French language and culture in relation with The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CECRL). The following examinations can also be taken depending on the schedule: <u>DELF</u> and <u>DALF</u> during studies at the ILCF, depending on the schedule.

Level test

On the first day of each session, students are required to take a test to evaluate their oral and written skills, so that they can be allocated to the correct group.

Validation of credits

Assessment method: continuous assessment Validation: 8 ECTS equivalence
