Application Procedure	Once the student is nominated by the home university, we send the application form and the courses catalogue to her/him. The student is then asked to fill in the application and return it to: fac.droit.international@univ-catholyon.fr
Application Deadline	15 th June for Fall semester and Full academic year 01 st November for Winter semester
Academic Requirements for Admission to the Exchange Program	At the discretion of the home university
Semester Dates	Fall semester: early September to 21 st December /provisional, to be confirmed Winter semester: early of January – End of May
Orientation Program	Compulsory 1 st semester: early September 2 nd semester: early January

Visa	<p>Who needs a visa?</p> <p>If you are a citizen of the European Economic Area (European Union, Iceland, Liechtenstein or Norway), Switzerland, Andorra or Monaco, you do not need a visa, a valid ID card or passport is sufficient.</p> <p>If you are not a citizen of one of these countries, you must get a long stay visa and a valid Passport.</p> <p>To apply for a visa, contact your nearest French embassy or consulate. Living Expenses	<p><i>This is only an estimate of the costs students will have to support for everyday life in Lyon: some costs are subjected to change!</i></p> <p>Housing fees</p> <p>University's residences: from 408€ / per month + 15€ electricity</p> <p>Room or flat in the city: per month = from 350€ (room in the owner's house), from 400€ month (shared apartment), from 550€ (a studio)</p> <p>Lodging with a host family: from 670€ / month</p> <p>Private student residence: from 540€ / month</p> <p>Other expenses</p> <p>Monthly electricity, gas and telephone bill: 60€ on average</p> <p>City transport: 32,50€ for a monthly subscription</p> <p>Vélov (rent a bike in the city) : 17€ / year</p> <p>Food: about 200€ / month. Lunch at the university cafeteria is around 4€</p> <p>A movie ticket: 7 €</p>
