CALL FOR PAPERS

An international conference will inaugurate the year of celebration of the fourth centenary of the death in Lyon of Saint Francis de Sales on December 28, 1622. It will be held in three languages: French, Italian and English. This conference aims to bring together the study of the theological, literary and historical approaches of Francis de Sales, under three main headings:

1 Francis de Sales, his formation, his development, his spiritual life

The context of the beginnings of Salesian Spirituality : a period of crisis

The Parisian spiritual crisis and its resolution, against the backdrop of a dispute over grace

The question of Francis de Sales' sources

2 The public words of a bishop

St Francis de Sales and the Protestants A theology for all in the vernacular, to make God accessible to all

The Ecclesiology of Francis de Sales

3 The private words of the spiritual man

Pascal to Francis de Sales

The demanding kindness of a spiritual director
The expression of spiritual life and direction
Francis de Sales, a model forof confessors
The direction of conscience and inner freedom, from

Paper presentations will be 30 minutes long, followed by questions and answers.

The text of the papers will be translated beforehand by the students of ESTRI, the school of translators of the Catholic University of Lyon and shared onscreen in the other two languages during the speaker's intervention.

A roundtable discussion will bring together the speakers at the end of each half-day.
