Course Catalogue	University Diplomas courses are regularly held on the same days and times (Lyon campus: Thursday afternoon, Annecy Campus: Wednesday afternoon) and it may lead to scheduling clashes with other modules you may select. Please note that the ESDES (Business School) has a different academic calendar and rules: classes start earlier than the Law School ones (early September/early January).
French Language course	Students can enroll for free to the French Language courses [30 hours / semester] and may earn 4 ECTS. Levels from A1 (beginners) to C1 (proficient), determined by a placement test.
Grading	We use the 20 points scale in line with the official French grading system. A grade of 20 represents the highest grade, 0 the lowest and 10 stands for a sufficient achievement.

Housing fees	University's residences: from 420€ / per month + 15€ electricity
