DESCRIPTION

These French as a Foreign Language courses are open to all international exchange students at UCLy, through their academic unit.

Taught throughout the two semesters of the academic year, the course covers the 4 CEFR skills: oral production, oral comprehension, written production and written comprehension.

Once enrolled, students take a test to determine their language level.

These 30-hour courses per semester earn 3 ECTS credits, and details of classrooms and timetables will be sent to students before each session.

Hours: 3h per week for 10 weeks, i.e. 30h per semester

Timetable: 2 sessions of 1h30 per week Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 6:00 to 7:30 pm

Location: Carnot campus

ECTS credits: 3 Level of French on enrolment: A2 to B2
