

 - ~ Lower genital infections, screening, treatment.

The 'Mission Handicap' Disability Service is aimed at:

- ~ students who have already benefited from some form of assistance or accommodation during their school career, whether for exams or studies
- ~ students who have never taken any particular steps, but who are encountering difficulties in their studies due to health problems or persistent disorders (learning difficulties, mental health, etc.)
- ~ students who have a temporary impediment during the year (fracture, hospitalization, etc.).

This approach is confidential, voluntary, individual and personalized. The support offered follows your pace of study (an annual assessment is proposed) and is tailored to your profile, coursework and future plans. Mission Handicap is the point of contact and follow-up with your program of study.

What is considered a disability?

Several types of special needs are affected by disability: learning difficulties, mental health struggles, hearing/visual impairments, motor disabilities, and more.

How can I find out more?

Talk with the Mission Handicap coordinator or read more in the FAQs on the student intranet (under Student life/Health and disability)

When should I make an appointment?

As soon as possible to avoid falling behind in your studies.

> Please note: A 7-day waiting period is required for practical implementation.


