- Implemented since 1990
- Supported more than 3000 scholars
- Aims at increasing the number of experts on the EU Acquis within the framework of Türkiye's accession process to the EU
- Provides scholarships for academic studies related to EU Acquis Chapters at graduate/research level for periods of min 3, max 12 months, at all universities and similar institutions in all EU member countries and in all EU official languages
- Financed by the European Union and implemented by the Directorate for EU Affairs in collaboration with the Central Finance and Contracts Unit and the Delegation of the European Union to Türkiye

Who can apply?

- Those currently working in Türkiye in public sector (including employees of the public corporate bodies established by law or presidential decree such as professional organisations, chambers and local administrations –municipalities, special provincial administrations–, development agencies, public development and investment banks, public deposit banks, etc.)
- Those currently studying as senior or graduate (master's or PhD) students in universities in Türkiye
- Those currently working in universities in Türkiye as academic or administrative staff
- Those currently working in private sector [including the employees of resident diplomatic missions, non-governmental organisations (NGOs), etc.]

Application Process

- JMSP is announced once a year.
- Applications to be submitted via hand delivery or post/courier to the Central Finance and Contracts Unit till the deadline specified in the announcement.

Selection Process

- Applicants who submit valid and compliant application documents are entitled to take the written exam.
- List of award holders are determined according to their written exam scores and sectoral quotas in terms of success ranking.

Amount of the Scholarship

- Tuition fees
- Living expenses differing according to the EU member country (accommodation, meals, communication, local transportation, cultural activities)
- Fixed amount (for various expenses such as passport, visa, travel, registration with local authorities, books/thesis, study visit, health and insurance, any tax liabilities and similar expenses)
